REVISED PROGRAM

This walking tour will START and END at the Rotary Park Terminal Building on Southern Ave. This Tour will focus only on the area of the Southside, south of the Mohawk River and Barge Canal. If you took this tour in the past, and you could not finish beyond Casler Street, or finished sooner, come hear the stories you missed, and new ones!
